

- Supporting black and minoritised individuals to form a representative group that will influence across all Surrey systems




Integration: Many Hands Project

Community Safety: Active Communities Project


 Creating a reflective space to discuss social ills; Domestic abuse, Drug & Alcohol abuse, Harmful Traditional Practices

- Raising Awareness on Cyber Crime, Internet Safety for parents, Child Sexual Exploitation




Empowering women, supporting vulnerable women and girls Trust Project

Capacity building our Members: Trust Project


- Providing Member Groups with support and guidance on charity governance

Engagement with black and minority communities with lived experience of mental ill health


Mental Health stakeholder engagement project
