TB Alert invites you to a FREE two day TB training workshop in England that will give you the knowledge, guidance and access to resources to raise awareness of TB among local at-risk communities.

Rates of tuberculosis have been increasing for over 20 years: becoming more concentrated in certain population groups and regional pockets of high incidence. BME communities, the homeless population, drug and alcohol mis-users and people living with HIV are disproportionately affected.

It is crucial that people with TB are diagnosed and treated quickly to minimise transmission to others. However, many people do not know the symptoms, are unaware that TB is curable and treatment is free, or have unfounded fears or beliefs about the illness.

TB Alert, the UK's national TB charity, is spearheading the Department of Health's commitment to raise awareness of tuberculosis among the most vulnerable groups. This workshop is part of *The Truth About TB* programme, to build the capacity of third sector organisations to integrate TB into their work and become partners of local statutory agencies in the fight against TB – championing the patient voice.

Who should attend?

Programme managers, co-ordinators and project workers from third sector organisations working with the communities most at risk of TB.

- Meet local NHS service providers and gain an understanding of how your community/clients can access TB services
